

Townend Field Nature Reserve covers 20 acres of beautiful, varied landscapes like woodlands, wetlands, meadows, and streams. It's a brand-new nature reserve, packed with all kinds of local wildlife. Located right next to the road and footpath between Great and Little Ouseburn, it's a perfect spot for locals, Great Ouseburn Primary School, and visitors to easily enjoy and connect with nature as part of their daily routine.

The nature reserve features a variety of wetland habitats, including wet meadows, reed beds, bogs, marshes, as well as both running and still waters. A section of the reserve is designated as a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation. It provides a vital home for several bird species listed on the UK red list due to their decline, such as the Spotted Flycatcher, Grasshopper Warbler, Tree Pipit, and Curlew (pictured to the right). These species are included in the Birds of Conservation Concern 5 list.

## ESTABLISH A NATURE RESERVE

We're protecting British wildlife by turning this land into a safe haven for native species. The wide range of trees are cared for and protected. Low-density farming is done in a wildlife-friendly way. We check in regularly to see how nature's doing through careful surveying, and keep improving with a flexible plan that puts local biodiversity first.

The stunning views of Townend Field are a cherished part of both Ouseburn villages, even highlighted in the Conservation Area Character Appraisal. That's why UOCT is committed to preserving this space as a nature reserve — keeping it green, open, and protected forever. It's about protecting the past, celebrating the present, and securing the future of this special place.


# Family fundraising inspiration!

### NATURE-THEMED FUNDRAISERS

Sponsored Nature Walk – Set a distance goal and get people to sponsor you per mile or lap around the reserve.

Seed Bomb Sale – Make and sell wildflower seed bombs to help others create mini wildlife patches at home.

Plant Sale or Swap – Sell plants grown from seed or cuttings, or host a swap ' event with a small entry fee.





## CREATIVE & CRAFTY FUNDRAISERS

Nature Bake Sale – Sell cupcakes, cookies, or cakes decorated with animal or plant themes.

Craft for a Cause – Make and sell natureinspired crafts like painted pebbles, pinecone animals, or pressed-flower cards.

Upcycled Art Show – Create art from recycled materials and host a donation-based exhibition or auction.

### SIMPLE AT-HOME IDEAS

Penny Jar Challenge – Compete between families, classes, or teams to see who can fill a jar with the most spare change.

Wildlife Quiz Night – Host a quiz (inperson or online) with rounds on local wildlife, plants, and nature facts.


Grow-a-Sunflower Competition –
Participants pay to enter, and the tallest

Garden Games Afternoon – Organise games like a bug hunt race, wheelbarrow relays, or flower pot toss, with small entry fees.

Pop-Up Café – Serve teas, coffees, and cakes for donations.



## TOP TIPS FOR FUNDRAISING


If you are under 18, your parent/guardian is responsible for you. Please show them this pack and ensure they are happy with what you intend to do.


### **Contact us**
